

2011-2012 UIL ELIGIBILITY REPORTING DATES

With the move to a 9 week grading schedule, it is important to understand the effect the grading schedule has on UIL eligibility. In order for UIL to stay in line with those schools on a six week grading period, the first UIL eligibility report is run after the first six weeks of school – even though this is NOT the end of Allen’s grading period. After the first eligibility report is run at six weeks, UIL eligibility reporting will then catch up on the same schedule as Allen H.S. – at the end of week 8, week 16 (end of 1st semester), week 26 (end of 3rd grading period), and week 36 (end of school year).

Students that become ineligible will still have the opportunity to regain eligibility every 3 weeks if they are passing all classes. This will take place at the end of week 11, week 14, week 19, week 22, week 29, and week 32.

Below is a list of dates that grades must be entered, updated, and accurate by **8 am** on these **Monday** mornings because they will be used to determine eligibility for all students involved in UIL activities and Club activities that follow UIL eligibility rules.

October 3 rd , 2011 (UIL 6 weeks Report)	February 13 th , 2012 (Opportunity to Regain)
October 17 th , 2011 (End of 1 st Grading period)	March 19 th , 2012 (End of Grading Period)
November 7 th , 2011 (Opportunity to Regain)	April 9 th , 2012 (Opportunity to Regain)
December 5 th , 2011 (Opportunity to Regain)	April 30 th , 2012 (Opportunity to Regain)
January 2 nd , 2011 (End of 2 nd Grading Period)	May 31 st , 2012 (End of Grading Period)
