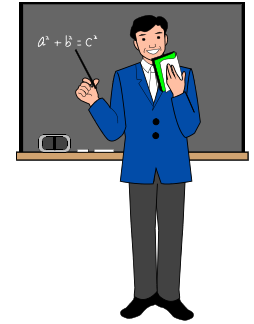

6th Grade Expectations



1. Be respectful of all people and property.

6. Incomplete/Missing Assignment (does not affect conduct grade, but student misses extra recess)

Conduct Grade for Report Cards

- Conduct marks on communication card are from all classes and all teachers except specials.
- Outstanding 0 - 3 marks
- Satisfactory 4 - 6 marks
- Needs Improvement 7 - 11 marks
- Unsatisfactory 12 +

Loss of communication card = 10 conduct marks off

General Classroom Procedures

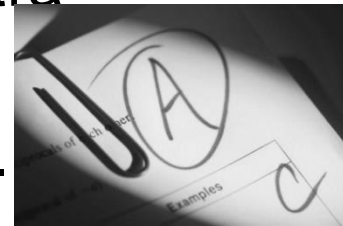
- Student must have a **chapter book** at his/her desk at all times.
- All students are responsible for writing daily assignments in agendas as teachers will not be checking them on a daily basis.

Wednesday Papers

- All 6th graders should take home their red communication folder and purple Viking folder each Wednesday.
- Please look through the purple Viking folder for newsletters, graded papers and other important school information.
- Please sign and return Viking folder each Thursday.
- If an entry has been made in the red communication folder, please sign it.

Grading Procedures

- If a student fails an assignment due to lack of objective mastery, the objective will be re-taught. Homework will not be given in advance for unexcused absences (trips, competitions, etc.)
- Grades recorded in the grade book will be circled on your child's paper.
- Late work will receive an automatic deduction of 10 points per day and student will not participate in extra recess on Friday.

- Grades should be checked in Family Access.
- Paper report cards are not sent home unless student has a failing grade in one or more subjects; however, report cards are accessible in Family Access.



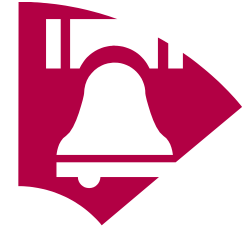
Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

- Students should be dropped off no earlier than 7:25 a.m. as there is no supervision before this time.
- All 6th graders will wait in their assigned area in the gym until they are dismissed.
- At the end of the school day, you may pick your child up in the carpool line at the front of the building.
- If your 6th grader has to meet a younger sibling, he/she needs to meet them in the designated location.
- Students should be at school by 7:40 a.m. The tardy bell rings at 7:45 a.m.
- Lunch meals should be purchased before school in the cafeteria.
