Natural Resources:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Limestone• Minerals• Streams• Fertile land for crops
Economic Resources:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Farming – fruits, vegetables, watermelons, oats• Ranching – Cattle, angora goats• Cedar trees – fenceposts• Oil and gas
