13th	Prohibited slavery in the United States
14th	Defined national citizenship Reduced state representation in Congress proportional to number of disfranchised voters Denied former Confederates the right to hold public office
15th	Prohibited denial of vote on grounds of race, color, or previous servitude

The End of Reconstruction

Eventually... White, Democrat *Redeemers* Regain Control of Southern Legislatures... and with the Election of Hays in 1877... Reconstruction (Radical) ends and *Jim Crow* begins...
