# Allowable Uses of Funding

Allowable activities for this grant include but are not limited to:

- Addressing learning loss and learning acceleration
- Planning and implementing summer learning
- Implementing activities to meet the learning needs of students
- Addressing the needs of low-income students
- Providing mental health supports
- Providing educational technology (including hardware, software, and connectivity)
- Purchasing supplies to sanitize and clean buildings
- School facility repairs and improvements to enable operations of schools to reduce the risk of virus transmission

# Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services Plan

This plan must address:

- How the district will maintain the health and safety of students, educators, and other staff.
- How the district will ensure continuity of services, including but not limited to services to address students' academic needs and students' and staff social, emotional, mental health and other needs.

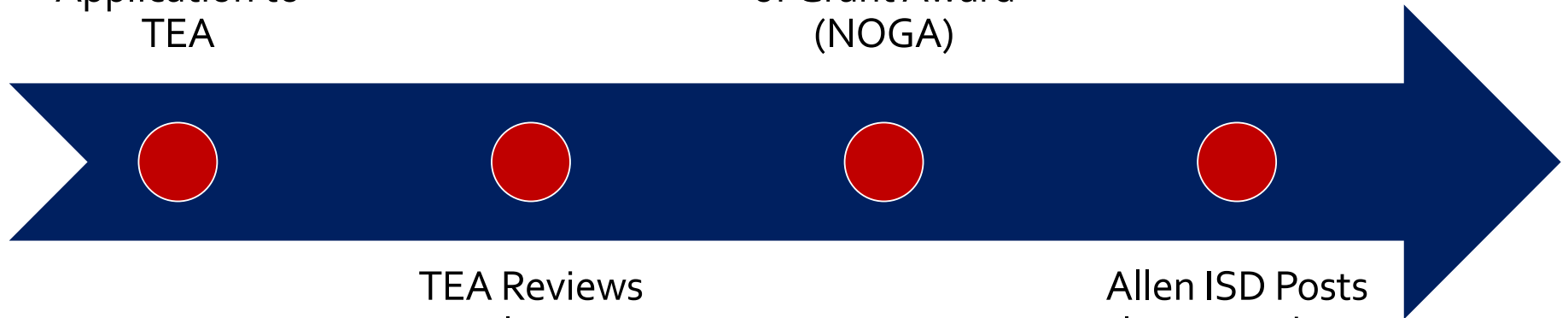
