<p>What is the problem, need or opportunity that this grant will address? Describe the impact of this project on your students.</p>	<p>Art has told the story of cultures for centuries. These lessons inform, enlighten and guide the student through historic events that include geography, math, language arts, literature, humanities, sports, religion, and so much more. Through this Art in History project the students will research, analyze and organize information, and finally create an Ancient Greece - Drinking Vessel (900-700 BC). The students will specifically be looking at the rich history behind these artifacts. Each student will create a replica of Greek pottery that they get to decorate to reflect the time period and culture from the ancient Greece era. There will be in depth investigation, much discussion and research before the students create their piece of art. This project is a perfect example of how we can get our students to work at the highest depth of knowledge level.</p>
<p>How will the project or program be implemented? Describe activities and tasks. Who is the target population and in what ways will they benefit?</p>	<p>Art In History's replica is an example of a drinking vessel from ancient Greece, called an "oinochoai". This pottery piece was made in the Geometric style between 900 - 700 B.C. The lesson covers Ancient Greece, 900-700 BC. This kit includes: replica, paint brush, sponge, disposable paint pallets, paint, and FREE lesson download. Lesson contains: history of the artifact, history of the time period, full color map, designs & motifs, and step-by-step decorating instructions. A teacher's guide is recommended for teaching instructions and lessons. AIM students in grades 1,2,and 3 will have the opportunity to create Greece replica drinking vessels to accentuate the learning experience, as we study the art and artifacts from the ancient Greek era. We will learn how artifacts tell the story of ancient peoples from early civilizations that we wouldn't know about any other way.</p>

<p>What teaching methods will be used to implement this project?</p>	<p>Critical thinking and problem solving will be taught along with art appreciation, in depth research, and analyzing skills. There will be modeling in order to ensure that proper techniques are being used.</p>
<p>What is the project timeline and the date of implementation?</p>	<p>Students will research ancient Greek art and architecture, along with Greek pottery and the stories told on the pots. They will also learn about the ancient Greek customs, including all aspects of an ancient civilization throughout the 2022-2023 school year.</p>
