 - Middle school curriculum Grades 6-8
 - High school Health I & II
 - 100% aligned with TEKS
 - Provides language support
 - Provides various resources for flexibility
 - Core content and “Opt-in” material are separated into two areas
 - State approved adopted resource
 - Goodheart-Willcox’s philosophy - Leads to a path of health mastery
 - Activities that allow educators to see content mastery by students
 - Provides teacher support – Lesson plans are already created (plans are editable)
 - Supports learning in core curriculum subjects (i.e. reading, writing, etc.)
 - Standards-based grading assessments
 - Alternative lesson resources for students not “opted-in”
 - Local Representative: Brad Blankenship
 - Handout: Pamphlet on Health-Based Education by Goodheart-Willcox

- Access to content will be distributed to SHAC members
 - Members to review curriculum and bring talking points to March SHAC meeting
 - Review of “opt-in” material is available in the ‘Companion Text’

 - Elementary curriculum grades K-5
 - 100% aligned with TEKS
 - Built in cooperation with medical and health professionals
 - Curriculum is 100% online
 - Controlled online content for students
 - Curriculum is flexible
 - Language support is not 100% - Spanish will be supported by the end of the year
 - Parents have access to resources
 - Grade level appropriate – Lesson plans are aligned with TEKS and SB 9
 - Conversation-based activities
 - Letters for parents are available in English and Spanish
 - QR code links available for parents
 - Curriculum customizable
