



## SHAC Minutes- Meeting Summary

April 5, 2022

Administration Building

Room 103-105, 6:30PM

**Members Present:** Jason Baughman, Vicky Bayer, Patty Chavez, Bob Cabbage, Geoben Johnson, Cheryl (Loving) Evans, Sarah Mitchell, Amrita Osahan, Kirsten Reitzammer, Johnna Walker

**Call to Order:** At 6:32 pm. Announcement by Johnna Walker that a quorum is present, that the meeting has been duly called, and that notice of the meeting has been duly posted for the time and manner as required by law. SHAC meeting requirements and norms were read by Johnna Walker.

SHAC Chair, Johnna Walker, welcomed all present to the meeting.

Assistant Superintendent Jennifer Wilhelm and Deputy Superintendent Daniel Pitcock were introduced by Johnna Walker.

SHAC members reviewed the minutes from the March 22, 2022 meeting. A motion was made to approve the March minutes by Kirsten Reitzammer and seconded by Geoban Johnson. The motion passed unanimously.

### Agenda Item #1

Jason Baughman states that SHAC can adopt 2 resources and designate a “preferred” curriculum.

Discussion on Quaver:

- Quaver K-5
- Aligned with TEKS
- Comments
  - Bob Cabbage was concerned about Quaver SEL being part of SHAC adoption
  - Jason Baughman states that Quaver SEL is not included in the human sexuality adoption; AISD would be purchasing only the Growth and Development/Puberty modules
  - Patty Chavez remarked that Quaver is still developing the Spanish module

A motion was made by Patty Chavez to approve *Quaver: Special Topics, Growth and Development/Puberty* instruction for human sexuality in grades K-5. The motion was seconded

by Amrita Osahan. The motion passed. Jason Baughman and Geoben Johnson abstained from voting due to Quaver being part of the Instruction Material Adoption.

#### Discussion on Procter & Gamble:

- Procter and Gamble
  - Elle Holland (Comments were read by Johnna Walker from an email sent by Elle) wrote that the girls video had useful information on health habits and menses; the boy's video was informative and covered health topics well
  - Bob Cabbage did not like the advertising that Procter and Gamble included in the videos
  - Jason Baughman confirmed that the Procter and Gamble videos meet the 4th grade requirements for TEKS
  - Amrita Osahan was enthusiastic about the Procter and Gamble videos including the sections on health habits; Amrita's son liked the video; Amrita was pleased that the video included; while the body is preparing for adulthood, children are not yet ready to be adults

A motion was made by Kirstin Reitzammer to approve *Procter and Gamble: Always Changing and Growing Up* as the preferred instruction for human sexuality in 4th grade. The motion was seconded by Amrita Osahan. The motion passed unanimously.

#### Discussion on Marshmedia:

- Marshmedia
  - **The New You** (3-5) Reviewing for 4th grade
    - Bob Cabbage liked how the video mentioned hygiene is a part of health and that it suggested students reach out to adult sources with questions; well done, "I like it."
  - **Just Around the Corner:** (4-6) Reviewing for 5th grade
    - Bob Cabbage added the video was well done and covered the necessary information
    - Amrita Osahan felt Marshmedia did not have updated video styles
  - **Growing Up:** (5-7) Reviewing for 6th grade
    - Bob Cabbage felt the video was thorough. It encouraged students to reach out to trusted sources; mentioned voice changes; talked about skin eruptions; graphics were clear and in good taste; talked about sperm and egg fertilizing; talked about exercise and menses; and went over proper hydration/nutrition/sleep habits. Bob gives his endorsement for the video
    - Johnna Walker commented about the video including topics such as fertilized eggs; puberty; and stressing that although bodies are able to make a baby, they are not mature enough to engage in adult behavior.
  - Elle Holland (Comments were read by Johnna Walker from an email sent by Elle) felt Marshmedia graphics were intense regarding women's private areas and hair growth
  - Bob Cabbage brought up other Marshmedia videos.
    - Discussion on Straight Talk:

- Bob Cabbage endorsed the Straight Talk videos. Says they have important topics that include responding to social situations
- Patty Chavez agrees the extra videos have good content and are well done
- Jason Baughman explained how Goodheart-Wilcox covers the topics needed for TEKS

Bob Cabbage and Elle Holland (via Johnna email) were concerned about the wording in the Goodheart-Wilcox text on “genetic material” from two individuals instead of using the words ‘male’ and ‘female’.

A list of public comments was distributed by Jason Baughman and Johnna Walker.

A motion was made by Bob Cabbage to approve *Marshmedia: Just Around the Corner* as the preferred human sexuality instruction in 5th grade. The motion was seconded by Vicky Bayer. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Bob Cabbage to approve *Marshmedia: Growing Up* as the primary human sexuality instruction in 6th grade. The motion was seconded by Jason Baughman. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Bob Cabbage to approve *Marshmedia: Straight Talk Series* as Supplemental Material for human sexuality instruction in grades 6-8. The motion was seconded by Patty Chavez. The motion passed unanimously.

Recommendations for the programs were finalized and will be presented to the Board of Trustees in May for consideration.

**Seconded by:** Cheryl (Loving) Evans. The motion passed unanimously.
