



AISD Middle School Athletic Events Plan

In order to meet the 2020-2021 guidelines and recommendations set by UIL, TEA, and local government agencies, the following changes will be in place for the 2020-2021 academic school year until further notice or changes made by the aforementioned agencies.

Ticketing at Allen ISD MS gymnasiums:

- **Basketball & Volleyball Ticket Sales**

- Tickets for home games may be purchased online ONLY using the following link and using a designated ID#. No tickets will be sold to the general public or at the gate. **Tickets will be redeemed electronically from the purchaser's smart device at the gate:**

- **HOME team** may only purchase four (4) tickets per participant using participant's last name (as it is in skyward & case sensitive) + student ID# for home games at Allen ISD MS gymnasiums. DO NOT PUT AN ID INTO THE PROMO CODE!
- Children 3 and under are not required to purchase a ticket, but must sit in parent/guardian's lap to attend without a ticket.
- NO PASSES ACCEPTED.
- **Students attending a middle school game must be accompanied by and sit with an adult during the event.**

- **Basketball & Volleyball Spectator Guidelines**

- Every other row will be marked off in the bleachers.
- All spectators are required to wear a mask as outlined by state/local policies.
- Spectators are expected to observe social distancing policies.
- All spectators will self-screen for COVID symptoms prior to entering an event.
- Spectators are encouraged to show up no earlier than 10-20 minutes prior to their student-athlete playing and encouraged to leave immediately following their student-athlete playing.
- When feasible, to assist with social distancing, please allow bleachers to begin clearing after a game before entering for the next game.
- Parents/Guardians are highly encouraged to take their student-athlete with them immediately following each game if possible. (Home & Away)
