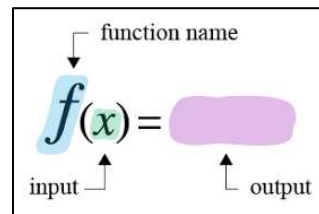

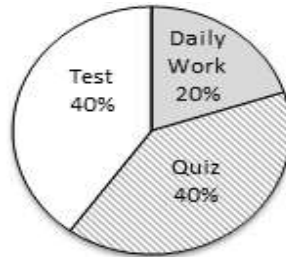
Students are required to abide by the school dress code at all times while on campus at AHS. Students out of dress code will be asked to fix the issue or go to the Discipline Center for consequences.

If you are expecting a call (i.e. job interview, family member in the hospital, etc.), please let Ms.LaBelle know before class and quietly go in the hallway to answer the call.

Grades:

Tests = 40%
Quizzes = 40%
Daily Grades = 20%
Recall Practice = Not Graded
Checkpoints = Not Graded



Students may use a 3x5 inch note card on quizzes, which must be turned in with the quiz. Notes and note cards are not allowed on tests or re-quizzes.

Students will maintain a binder to be graded each unit as a quiz grade.

Do not copy work from another student or the internet. Plagiarized work will receive a zero and the student will be referred to the Discipline Center for violating the Academic Honor Code.

Late Work

Students have up to 1 week to turn in late work for a maximum grade of 70%. Zeros will be entered into the grade book immediately on the due date. No homework will be accepted after 1 week late.

Make-up Work

Students who are absent are responsible for getting their notes and assignments from Canvas and Skyward. Students are allowed one class day for each absence. Zeros will be entered into the grade book on the new due date. Missed tests and quizzes must be taken in the Testing Center within 3 school days.

Re-Takes

Students may retake quizzes and tests within a two week window of the grade being entered into Skyward. No note cards or notes are allowed on re-quizzes or re-tests.

On a re-quiz, students may receive up to half of the original missed points back.

On a re-test, students may receive a maximum of 70%.

To be eligible for a re-take, students must:

- Have completed the review assignment,
- Attend a tutorial,
- Complete the Quiz or Test Correction page,
- Take the re-take in the Testing Center within 2 weeks of the grade being entered in Skyward.

For Test scores between a 60 and 69, students do not need to retake the test only complete the Test Correction page.
