**Safety Reminders for Carpool:**

- ◆ Always pull as far forward as you can in the line
- ◆ Students should keep the door of the vehicle closed until it comes to a complete stop next to the curb and then exit and enter the car from the curbside only.
- ◆ Each car must display the 'car tag' from the rearview mirror (let your child's teacher know if you need another tag).
- ◆ **NO** cell phone use in school zone and/or in carpool lane

**Front Drive:**

- \*7:30-8:30AM and 2:30-3:30PM  
For Daycare vans & School buses
- \*8:30AM - 2:30PM - parents may use this drive and parking lot to pick up student for appointments or emergencies

**As the safety of every student, staff member, and parent is of top priority, we ask that parents work with us to ensure the drop off and pick up of students provides social distancing and kindness for all.**

Carpool is the best option, if at all possible:

- Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup> grade, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, and the older siblings will enter and exit the building on the 'Silver Side'
- 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, & 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will enter and exit on 'Purple Side' (unless with younger sibling on Silver)
- Students in 4<sup>th</sup> grade and older are required to wear a mask – recommended for younger students

Independent Walkers:

- Should wear a mask and be aware of their surroundings (mask required for 4<sup>th</sup> grade and older – recommended for the younger)

Parents walking with their student:

- Should wear a mask and be aware of their surrounding (mask required for 4<sup>th</sup> grade and older – recommended for the younger)
- Parents need to let their student go at the edge of school property or sooner (see the red stars), before school and/or after school. This is to provide social distancing for these students, the students walking independently, the students being dropped off in carpool, and staff on duty.

Parking in the parking lot and walking your student to the building/door is not a good option for anyone. This will not provide respectful social distancing for you, your student, all other students, or the staff on duty. Please refrain from this practice.
