On September 1, 2012, Senate Bill 471 (Preventing Child Sexual Abuse and Maltreatment), went into effect. This bill requires school district staff be trained in the warning signs of abuse and how to report it. This bill also requires school districts to educate students on these same issues.

The Allen ISD Counseling Department is offering parents the opportunity to virtually preview the presentation that will be shown to your 4th–6th grade children. This presentation will cover the topics of healthy vs. unhealthy relationships as well as the various forms of child abuse. It will also educate students on what to do if they or a friend are being abused. Attached you will find the information contained on the slides relating to child abuse.
