

It's **MORE** than a **MEAL**

Submitting your application for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) can do more than just provide access to free and reduced-price meals. Families must meet eligibility criteria for each program listed. Additional applications may still be needed to secure benefits.

Apply Now for Free and Reduced Meal Benefits and your name will be added into a drawing for a chance to win the following: a bicycle, a flat screen TV or a grill!

If you have already applied for free or reduced meals for the 2021-2022 school year, you are automatically entered into the drawing. You do NOT need to submit another application for a chance to win. The deadline to be entered into the drawing is January 14th. Winners will be notified.



SCHOOL MEALS

Establishes eligibility for free or reduced prices on school meals. In addition, approved applications during the 2021-2022 school year will ensure student eligibility for free or reduced-price meals during the first 30 days of the 2022-2023 school year while applications are being processed.



COLLEGE RESOURCES

May provide reduced registration fees for AP, SAT and/or ACT tests and discounted rates associated with college applications.



TECHNOLOGY

Eligible families could receive up to \$50 per month discount on your Broadband bill and qualify for a discounted insurance fee of \$15 on their device.



SCHOOL FUNDING

May provide additional funding for state and federal programs and services at your school.



COMMUNITY SERVICES

Eligible families registered in the Kid's Club Afterschool Program may receive a discount on tuition.



PANDEMIC BENEFITS

Determines eligibility to receive Pandemic EBT benefits if requirements are met.
