

Grade Point Tables Class of 2011 and Beyond

The highlighted areas below provide a representative comparison of the grades necessary to obtain 3.85 grade points at each of the three levels. Example: A student who earns a grade of 97 in a regular English 3 class will receive 3.85 grade points; however, in an AP English 3 class the student will only need to earn a 77 to receive 3.85 grade points.
