Transfer Guidelines/Agreement

Transfer requests are subject to campus capacity constraints. AISD has the sole discretion to determine whether space exists at requested transfer site. No transfer will be approved to a campus that has 90% capacity for the grade level requested. Parents have the responsibility of providing safe transportation for any child requesting transfer from zoned campus. All transfer applications are for the current school year only. Students on transfer must follow all rules and regulations of the District, including those for student conduct and attendance.

Any person who knowingly falsifies information on a form required by the District for enrollment of a student commits an offense under Section 37.10 of the Texas Penal Code, which offense is a Class A misdemeanor unless the person's intent is to defraud or harm another, in which event the offense is a felony of the third degree. Class misdemeanors are punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,000.00; confinement in jail for a term not to exceed one year, or both. Third degree felony is punishable by a prison sentence for any term of not more than ten years or less than two years and additionally by a fine not to exceed \$5,000.00.

Student transfers **may be denied or revoked** due to poor attendance, excessive tardies, failure to pick up students at dismissal time, lack of parental cooperation, and/or behavioral issues. If the District discovers that a student's assignment to a campus was based on false or misleading information from the student or parent, the student shall be assigned immediately to the attendance zone campus.
