Art has told the story of cultures for centuries. These lessons inform, enlighten and guide the student through historic events that include geography, math, language arts, literature, humanities, sports, religion, and so much more. Through the Art in History projects the students will investigate a specific time period and culture. Each student will create a replica of a piece of art that they get to decorate to reflect the time period and culture from which it originated.

There will in depth investigation, much discussion and research before the students create their piece of art.

Project Description

Each student will receive a kit that includes a historically accurate replica of a piece of art from the time period they are studying. The kits include everything the student will need including the artifact, paint, brushes, sponges and

disposable paint palettes.

The 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th and 6th grade AIM students will use the Art in History pieces as well as their research findings to gain an understanding of the culture and time period they are studying. They will display their art in school and have the opportunity to not only showcase their pieces but they will be able to explain what was significant about their piece of art and why did they decorated it the way they did.
