The purpose of the Soaring like an Eagle grant is to provide first generation English Language Learners (ELL) the opportunity to become informed about their post-secondary options. This grant will allow us to introduce them to college programs that are available to them after high school. Many of the families of these students have not gone beyond a high school education. We want these students to have all the information available to them to make an informed decision after high school graduation.

Soaring Like an Eagle grant will allow 60 of our ELL students to visit several community college campuses in the area during the 2015-2016 school year. The intended outcome of this grant is that our students will know what resources are available to them and have the knowledge to make an informed decision about the post-secondary education.

The Allen ISD mission statement is about being innovative in education to empower every learner to realize his or her full potential. I feel like this grant helps us reach that mission. Exposing students to a college campus within the community allows our student to expand their learning outside of Lowery Freshman Center and Allen High School. This grant will allow us to foster their desire to further their education and increase their confidence in attaining goals they have set for themselves.

Measurement

The effectiveness of the grant will be measured by following up with the students about community college and discussing how their goals can be reached. Participants will write an essay and complete a survey to check for understanding and this will give us a chance to follow up on any questions they have after the visit. We will have our college and career advisers available and ensure they have an understanding of the process. This will remove some of the fear or barriers of applying for and attending college.

Teaching Methods

Students will be working with their counselor and/or English teacher and research different programs and classes available at the college level online and in class prior to any visits. In addition they will research scholarships and grants that they would be eligible for. From there they will prepare questions in preparation for their visit to the campuses.
