focus on the history of cameras/photography, macrophotography, and programs for imagery manipulation. 6th graders will learn to differentiate between poor/good photography and utilize the camera to capture history/events, portraits, still life, genre, and/or landscapes. All 4th, 5th, and 6th grade students will create and keep and updated ePortfolio comprised of their personal works.
