Project Purpose

The Outdoor Adventures program has the National Archery in Schools Program as a major part of it curriculum. Within the NASP setting we instruct each and every student in the skills and safety for the sport of Archery. Our students work very and hard deserve to have the opportunity to attend few tournaments. This year the Archery Team competed at the State NASP Tournament in Belton, Texas and placed 1nd in the State. This finish has qualified the team to go to Nationals in Louisville, Kentucky in May. Practice is four days a week and involves approximately 1000 to 1500 arrows going into the targets each of those days. The need is for transportation to get kids to some tournaments to assess their progress from so many hours of

practice. This program services from 7-12th grade.

The target population that this programs serves ranges from 7th -12th grade in Allen Schools. All students enrolled in Outdoor Adventures 9-12 and all students on the Archery Team. The numbers are between 80-150 students per school year. The transportation will allow for all of our athletes including our lower economic students the chance to travel to show their skills that they have worked so hard to accomplish in practice.

Measurement

What specific measurements will be used to evaluate the effectiveness of the project? (500 words or less)

The effectiveness of the project has been proven through the success that has been experienced by all involved within the Outdoor Adventures program and the Allen ISD Archery Team. Third Place finish at State in the 2012 State Tournament, Second Place finish in the 2013 State Tournament and 1st place in the 2014 and 2015 state tournament.. In the 2012 Tournament an individual student tied for 1st Place overall and in the 2013, 2014, and 2015 Tournament we had a outright Individual State Champion. These results and the continued growth in the Outdoor Adventures program since its beginning in Allen ISD speak volumes for this need.

Teaching Methods

Both Coaches are NASP certified instructors with a wealth of knowledge and experience and use these attributes to build and grow confidence within the students in the ability to participate and experience success as Archer. With between 400-600 student/Archers per school year we are teaching a great number of students a lifetime sport they can enjoy for decades. The opportunities for scholarship funds for college are provided at both the State and National levels.
