This next phase is a focus on developing students' leadership potential. The Leader in Me model will assist us in equipping our students with the academic and life skills necessary for future success. The Leader in Me is based around the 7 Habits of Highly Effective People which Stephen Covey outlined for the first time in his 1989 book. These habits/principles are universal and timeless, and can be taught to young children!

The 7 Habits are:

Habit 2: Begin With the End in Mind

Habit 3: Put First Things First

Habit 4: Think WinWin

Habit 5: Seek First to Understand, Then to Be Understood

Habit 6: Synergize

Habit 7: Sharpen the Saw (Care for Body, Mind, Spirit)

Implementation of The Leader in Me is a three year process and will benefit ALL Green students, their families, and faculty members. ◆◆◆ Development of New Student Leadership Opportunities Ongoing Throughout 2017-2018 School Year  
◆◆◆ Student Training in Goal Setting Ongoing Throughout 2017-2018 School Year

We will implement all student and family components in September 2017. Full implementation will take approximately three years.
