Project Description

Students will have "Silent Game Days" to practice using the language. These days will mimic a Deaf community experience, known in Deaf culture as a Deaf Club. Deaf Clubs are a way for Deaf people to come together with their community to socialize and discuss current events impacting the Deaf community. Students will also use the games as a fun way to review and use the language.

This project will allow our American Sign Language (ASL) students to interact in a fun meaningful way in the target language giving them the experience of being a part of Deaf culture within the school. These experiences will be much like that of the Deaf community where students are able to use their knowledge of ASL to interact with others around them. This project will foster a more natural language progression for the students' second language acquisition.

This project will utilize the TEKS of interpersonal, interpretive, and presentational components as the students will interact with one another and the teacher in many manners. Teacher will facilitate activities as a large group and as smaller groups. Students will be strengthening their ASL skills both as they play the games and even beyond that in the classroom. This format will provide the teacher with opportunities to both observe and interact with students to record their progress. The monitoring and assessing will continue throughout the school year.
