Project Purpose

What is the problem, need or opportunity that this grant will address? Describe the impact of this project on your students. (500 words or less.)

For various reasons, many of students do not qualify for PreK, but could benefit greatly from the learning experiences provided in a storytime setting to help them begin Kindergarten with a stronger foundation of literacy and math skills. At the beginning of each school year, the common deficits in the kindergarten students are letter identification with letter sounds, vocabulary, listening comprehension, and beginning number sense. There is also the need for building social skills, such as sitting for a short period of time to listen to a story, sharing materials, etc. When a child is lacking in these skills, they may be considered "At-Risk" for not graduating. By providing the Future Falcon Storytime with engaging literacy and math activities to incoming kindergarteners, it can help give them a boost for entering Kindergarten the following year, which can then lead to a more successful school career.

This program will help support future learning by providing opportunities to practice listening, speaking, reading, and math skills. Future Falcon Storytime will provide those experiences, as well as helping parents and caregivers by modeling strategies, offering tips, and providing tools to strengthen the home and school connection.

Project Description

The target population is for incoming kindergarten students for the 2019-2020 school year. This storytime program will be a monthly offering beginning in the spring semester (January 2020). Each storytime will have an objective, and will consist of a read aloud, a cooperative game or song, a hands on activity, and a take home kit containing items related to the day's activities and skills. Included in the take home kit will be a few books, a literacy or math game, and other manipulative items to support learning at home.

Future Falcons Storytime is a monthly program for incoming Story kindergarten students. Children will participate in a read aloud, games, songs, and hands-on activities. Parents and caregivers will be given a take home kit each month to support their child's learning at home.

Each month will feature an author and the read aloud and activities will be connected to that author. I will begin with a read aloud with a clear skill objective, next there will be a game or song to practice the skill, then a hands-on activity for the caregiver and student to do together while I support and equip the parent or caregiver with tips on how to support their child, as well as, guiding conversations and dialogue. The caregiver will then get a take home kit that reinforces the skills of the day.

Timeline

- September- Identify children that will begin K at Story for the 2019-2020 school year.
- October- Order materials.
- November- Prepare kits and lessons.
- December- Invite identified incoming K students to participate in the program.
- January- Begin the monthly storytimes.
- May- Last storytime celebration and Parent/Caregiver survey.
