With this grant, I hope to hone in on some skills that will be transferable to the workplace someday. Students will practice sorting various items within the classroom such as chips, candy, different brands of toothpaste, silverware, etc. and then the teachers will take the students to different locations around the school to practice the implementation of these skills. Students will help out in the cafeteria by restocking their chips, candy, silverware and napkins. Students will help sort mail and shred documents for our house offices, with hopes that by graduation they will have developed the skills necessary to gain employment in these areas.

The target population is students in the Life Skills classroom. It will benefit them by putting them on a track for employment.

Teaching Methods

The activities use a structured teaching method. The approach includes a focus on the person with the varying disabilities and is designed around a person's skills, interests and needs. It is designed to increase independent functional skills by using modeling procedures, different levels of prompting, organized work stations in a left-right setting with a finished area for completed work. Tasks are designed to reduce and/or eliminate adult cueing and prompting.
