My hope is that this will have a positive impact on my students and it will carry over to all areas in their lives.

The equipment will be used in many activities, games, and stations to help students get better at working together, encouraging each other, and listen to each other. This equipment will be use in the physical education classroom and will benefit Kinder - 6th graders at Rountree. I'm not apposed to loaning out equipment to other schools for use with this purpose too. Some of the following activities are examples of how the equipment will be used. I've been looking for games that will allow my students to work on communicate in small groups or partners. I feel this will help them become better at listening, encouraging others, and working on teams. Here are just a few examples: Battleship - students work on small teams to try to save their ship. They have to listen to each other, share ideas, and work together to help their ship. The game requires mats, softie balls and bowling pins. Mission Is Possible is another game when students work on a team to make it from one end of the gym to the other. They have to listen to others ideas and implement them to see if they will be successful. They have to move as a team. This activity requires jump ropes, various types of poly spots and cones. Protect Your Pets - This is an activity where students work on teams to gather all the animals they can. They have to follow certain routes to get to the animals and bring them back home. Students work together to make a plan. This game uses rubber animals, poly spots and mats. Some equipment I already have for the games. I'm only looking for a few things that I need to add to what I already have.
