<p>The AP/IB Psychology students are taking a field trip to Terrell State. The purpose is to destigmatize mental health. Texas is 50th in mental health funding, and Terrell State Hospital is one of the few state facilities that provides for those that are often disregarded by society. During the visit, students will meet patients who are now employees at Terrell State Hospital. Students will also take a tour of the hospital facilities. So many students have a schema about mental hospitals as places of torture. Students need to see clients of the hospitals as individuals who are experiencing mental illness, which is an illness like diabetes. These are individuals who have hope for improvement.</p>

The trip has been planned. Students will be asked to pay \$11/each to cover the cost of transportation.
