Project Purpose

What is the problem, need or opportunity that this grant will address? Describe the impact of this project on your students. (500 words or less.)

The opportunity for students to learn how to properly prepare fresh vegetables and fruit from Anderson's Sprouting Stars Garden will increase their interest in having a healthy lifestyle. The Oklahoma Cooperation Extension service offered cooking classes of fresh produce to youth and adults, from these classes the fruit and vegetable intake almost doubled for both groups. Telling a child to eat their carrots is not the same as examining why carrots should be eaten and offering various ways to prepare carrots that will appeal to the children which will increase consumption.

This project will be implemented as a resource to include in the Anderson's Sprouting Garden classroom activities in grades kindergarten through sixth. As produce is harvested, a recipe will be chosen by the class, and consumed by the class. The student nutrition department will provide any extra needed consumables needed for the recipe. The school district's dietician will provide information about the benefits of the produce and other ingredients that is utilized in the recipe. A portable kitchen will allow for real life opportunities to read and complete recipes, which utilizes math concepts, cooperative learning between the students, reading comprehension, and following directions.
