Describe the impact of this project on your students.</p>	<p>With the focus of education shifting to increasing the rigor of learning in math, science and literacy, social studies/history is becoming an ever shrinking discipline. However, research asserts that studying history improves decision making and judgement, offers models of good and responsible human behavior, as well as how to learn from the mistakes of others. History provides a context for people to understand themselves and others and how modern society has evolved. This project will allow students the opportunity to develop a variety of skills through learning how the past has been interpreted and the biases and misunderstandings that may arise from it. Initially, 6th grade students will study a variety of cultures through the designated class expectations. They will then create learning opportunities for other students in a variety of grade levels with the information they have learned.</p>

The students in other grade levels that are learning about the lesson from 6th graders will have . The teachers from the classes taught will have a survey to fill out about the learning and engagement of the lesson the 6th graders teach.</p>
<p>What teaching methods will be used to implement this project?</p>	<p>Initially, I will facilitate learning in the 6th grade classroom of different regions of our world. Students will then illustrate their learning by creating a box of artifacts, activities, illustrations and interactive presentations, etc. of what they have learned. They will then make adaptations or adjustments to their boxes for a variety of other grade levels and then visit classrooms and teach what they have learned to small groups.</p>
<p>What is the project timeline and the date of implementation?</p>	<p>Fall 2020- 6th grade students will work through several units of learning including Geography, Latin America, Europe, etc. They will then visit classrooms 1-2 times as school wide/grade level schedules permit. Spring 2021- 6th grade students will work through several units of learning including Asia, Africa, Oceania, etc. They will then visit classrooms 1-2 times as school wide/grade level schedules permit.</p>
